Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.43, dated 08.06.2015, under Section 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Women, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

This Court, vide order dated 27.07.2015, has granted interim bail to the petitioner, however, subject to his joining the investigation and to comply with the provisions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 27.07.2015, petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable-Satinder Pal Singh, also states that petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

In view of the above, order dated 27.07.2015 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.

However, petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
