AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for interim bail in case bearing FIR No.181 dated 23.08.2014 registered under Sections 148, 149, 307, 302 IPC and 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act at Police Station Baroda, District Sonapat.

On 29.07.2015 the following order was passed :-

"Learned counsel for the petitioner states that his wife was burnt alive by the complainant party and FIR No.129 was registered on 07.06.2015. There is nobody in the house except old ailing father of petitioner who is aged about 85 years.

Notice of motion for 20.08.2015.

In the meanwhile State may apprise this Court about composition of the family as well as status of school going children of the petitioner."

Learned AAG on instructions from Inspector Raj Pal, SHO, Police Station Baroda, states that it has been verified that the petitioner has three children and there is no body except his 85 year old father in the house. It has also been verified that the daughter of the petitioner is continuing studies in Class-X but his two younger sons are no longer going to school since their fees have not been paid. He has stated that in these circumstances he would not oppose the interim bail to the petitioner but since he is the main accused a direction be issued to the trial Court to accept it only after taking heavy surety.

In the circumstances the petition is allowed. Let the petitioner be released on interim bail for one month by the trial Court subject to heavy surety.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
