**AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)**

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 7.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of his proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record extract of his Middle Standard Examination Certificate (Annexure P-1) wherein his date of birth is mentioned as 29.07.1989. Petitioner No.2 has also placed on record extract of her Matriculation Examination Certificate (Annexure P-2) depicting her date of birth as 29.10.1990. They have also moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Distt. Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present

petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, Senior Superintendent of Police, Distt. Hoshiarpur to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.

A copy of this order be given dasti to learned counsel for the petitioners on payment of usual charges.
