Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.PC to the three petitioners namely Charanjit Singh, Baldev Singh & Satnam Singh in case FIR No.167 dated 26.06.2015 for offence punishable under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Chandimandir, Panchkula.

As per the allegations, the atrocities of the three petitioners led their neighbour Rajinder Singh to commit suicide.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from SI Ramesh Kumar states that none of the petitioners have joined investigation.

After hearing learned Counsel for the parties and perusing the contents, it is apparent that there are direct allegations against the

petitioners-accused persons which forced Rajinder Singh to commit suicide.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, in view of the nature and gravity of the offences, no case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made out.

Dismissed.
