The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'Cr.P.C.') seeking quashing of the FIR No.87 dated 28.4.2010 (Annexure P-1), registered for offence punishable under Sections 452, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Sahnewal, District Ludhiana, on the basis of the compromise (Annexure P-3).

Heard.

Report of the trial court has been received that respondents No.2 and 3 have entered into compromise with petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that investigating agency has found petitioners No.1 and 2 as innocent and is under process of filing cancellation report qua them.

As the matter has already been amicably settled and the petitioners have also been found innocent by the police, the instant petition is allowed and the impugned FIR (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom is quashed qua the petitioners.
