The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.14, dated 1.2.2013, registered under Sections 15/61/85 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the case of the petitioner is covered by the decision of this Court in Parminder Kumar @ Pinder vs State of Punjab, decided on 2.12.2014, and that the same may be disposed of in the same terms.

Counsel for the respondent has accepted this factual assertion.

Resultantly, this petition is disposed of in the same terms as in

CRM-M No.25421 of 2014 (supra). It is clarified that the petitioner would

be entitled to the same benefit as was granted to Parminder Singh @ Pindu,
and in case the trial is not concluded within three months from 2.12.2014,
he would be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
