Petitioner seeks issuance of appropriate directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 for providing protection in respect of life, liberty and property of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has highlighted factum of pendency of civil suit in respect of possession of shop, wherein her husband is a tenant. Said civil suit is pending against respondent No.5. The grievance of petitioner addressed to respondent No.2 remained unredressed.

At this stage, without embarking upon merits of this case, respondent No.2 can be asked to have fair look into the representation dated 25.05.2015 filed by petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Arshdeep S. Kler, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Let three copies of the petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day. In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass there is no

necessity of filing reply.

Respondent No.2 may devise own mechanism to extract truth from the allegations contained in the representation. If the representation of petitioner is found to have some substance, then respondent No.2 may proceed to pass appropriate order in the context of life, liberty and property of petitioner in accordance with law.
