Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities particularly respondent No.3, petitioners have approached this Court by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking appropriate direction to the official respondents for taking appropriate action against respondent No.5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that when the genuine grievance of the petitioners was not being redressed, they finally approached the respondent authorities by way of self-contained representation dated 2.12.2014 (Annexure P-1), but the same is also pending decision. He further submits that the petitioners shall be satisfied in case they are granted liberty to supplement their above-said representation dated 2.12.2014 (Annexure P-1) and respondent No.3 is directed to consider and decide the same, within a reasonable time.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, the petitioners are directed to supplement their above-said representation dated 2.12.2014 (Annexure P-1) by moving a comprehensive representation within a period of three weeks from today. The Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib-respondent No.3 is directed that on receiving the comprehensive representation on behalf of the petitioners within a period of three weeks from today, he shall consider the grievance raised by the petitioners and decide the same at an early date, by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law but in any case within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the present petition stands disposed of.
