FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 19.05.2015 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st

Class, Ludhiana has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Poonam Gupta @ Sushma and the accused Rahul Gupta, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise arrived at between the parties is an outcome of voluntariness, free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, being a pure matrimonial dispute, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences and resolving the personal dispute, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.45 dated 28.05.2014 registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Ludhiana under Sections 406, 498-A IPC and all consequences arising thereof are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
