This order shall dispose of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.224 dated 13.12.2014, under Section 22/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station, City Sunam, District Sangrur.

Counsel for parties have been heard.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that FIR in question was registered in relation to a Naka having been put up on 13.12.2014 by the police upon a secret information against the present petitioner as also other co-accused as regards to selling intoxicant tablets/intoxicant substances after bringing the same from Haryana. As per prosecution version, a car bearing

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registration No.PB-31-S-8643 was intercepted and three persons sitting inside the car upon seeing the police party stopped the car and ran away. HC Chamkaur Singh stated to have duly identified these three persons including the present petitioner i.e. Jagsir Singh @ Seera as also Jagsir Singh @ Jaggi and Gupreet Singh @ Netar. Alleged recovery of 260 intoxicant tablets was effected.

So far as co-accused Jagsir Singh @ Jaggi, is concerned, he is stated to be a habitual offender and 8 other cases under the ND&PS Act have been registered against him.

The first bail application filed by the present petitioner was rejected by the learned Judge, Special Court, Sangrur on 22.12.2014. The petitioner till date has not joined the investigation and has been on run for the last 7 months.

In the light of such serious allegations and keeping in view the conduct of the petitioner, this Court is of the considered view that he is not entitled to the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition stands dismissed.
