LISA GILL, J.

This petition has been filed for a direction to respondent No. 3 for not harassing the petitioner and his family members and to open the locks put on the petitioner's house without any authority of law.

As per affidavit dated 23/24.09.2014 of Sh. Sukhamrit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Samrala Sub Division, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana as well as affidavit dated 29.10.2014 of Jarnail Singh, Sub Inspector, Formerly SHO Police Station Machhiwara, – respondent No. 3, no lock whatsoever was put by the police on the ancestral home of the petitioner. The matter had been adjourned on the request of learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, submits that the petitioner is now in possession of his ancestral home and this petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of accordingly.
