MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner is already before the civil court and has a protective injunction in his favour. In case his possession is still threatened by the private respondents, he would have remedy under Order 39 Rule 2-A CPC. The petitioner also alleges bias at the hands of respondent No.3, i.e. SHO of Police Station Lakho Ke Behram, who is allegedly in collusion with the private respondents who are threatening the petitioner with violence. If that is so, the petitioner would have a remedy under Section 156 (3) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of leaving the petitioner to his remedies in law.
