Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.86 dated 01.07.2015, under Section 15 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, Tehsil Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

Following order was passed by this Court on 17.08.2015:-

“List again on 10.09.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioners be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. Petitioners shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant

Sub Inspector Vijay Kumar has submitted that petitioners

have joined investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioners by this Court vide order dated 17.08.2015, is made absolute.
