Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner is not related to Inderjit Singh or Atama Singh. He further states that petitioner has joined the investigation and it is Inderjit Singh who is the main accused.

Learned State counsel on instructions submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 24.08.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custody is not required.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and recovery has been effected, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 24.08.2015 is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner will join the investigation as and when required by the police and will not tamper with evidence or hamper the investigation and will not leave India without permission of the Court and will comply with the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
