**ANITA CHAUDHRY, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 4 dated 06.01.2015 registered at Police Station Sadar, District Kapurthala under Sections 21/22/61/85 of NDPS Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that recovery effected from the petitioner is only 10 grams of heroine and ₹ 1.00 lac though recovery from the co-accused is commercial in nature. He further urges that petitioner was a stranger and she had nothing to do with the other persons and the case was planted. He further states that the trial is taking time.

Learned State counsel urges that besides this case there is another case pending against the petitioner and this is the second application moved on behalf of the petitioner. He had also submitted that there are cases pending against husband of the petitioner.

The petitioner was found travelling in a car with some persons. The allegations are that she used to travel with the samples. The weighing scale was also recovered. The total

recovery effected from occupants of the car is commercial in nature.

The husband of the petitioner is also involved in NDPS case.

There is bar under Section 37 of the NDPS Act. No case for bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
