JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Prayer is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No. 175, dated 17.11.2012 for the offences punishable under Sections 382, 323, 148, and 149 of the Indian Penal Code (Sections 392 and 397, IPC added later on), registered at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga.

As per the investigation, the petitioner alongwith his five other co-accused had committed a theft of Rs. 12,000/- and a mobile.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that earlier, the petitioner was granted bail by the trial Court, however, due to his non-appearance on a date, his bail bonds were cancelled and after being declared proclaimed offender, he was arrested on 08.12.2014. He further submits that the petitioner would not violate the terms and conditions of bail, if granted.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Judge Singh, states that the prosecution evidence is yet to commence.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period and the facts of the case as noticed above, this Court finds that petitioner/accused-Baltej Singh @ Bhola deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Moga.
