Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking appropriate directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to take action on the complaint dated July 30, 2013 submitted by petitioner to respondent No.3 and registered with Unique ID No. 357691 with the PSOC Shambu, District Patiala disclosing commission of cognizable offences.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that till date no action has been taken on the complaint dated July 30, 2013. Even, a letter dated July 29, 2013 (Annexure P-4) was also written by Assistant Executive Engineer, Operation, PSP Corporation Ltd. Banur to respondent No.3 alleging the commission of cheating with electricity department by Raghbir Singh. Even, that application has also not been enquired into by respondent No.3 till date.

3. At the asking of Court, Ms. Priyanka Sadar, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

4. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to enquire into the allegations unfolded in application dated July 29, 2013 (Annexure P-4) and in case found some substance therein, take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
