This is a petition for quashing of FIR No.328 dated 05.12.2009 under Sections 406/420/506 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Line, Patiala at the instance of respondent No.2 alleging that the petitioner alongwith his wife had taken a sum of Rs.4,71,000/- from the complainant as sale consideration for a plot in Patiala. After purchasing of plot the petitioner did not transfer the ownership in the name of the complainant.

As the parties entered into compromise, the present petition was filed for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.

The parties were directed to appear before the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Patiala. After recording the statements of the

parties, the learned Magistrate has send a report that the matter has been compromised voluntarily.

Counsel for the complainant has admitted that the transfer deed has been executed and on the basis of the same, mutation is to be entered.

I am satisfied that the matter has been compromised voluntarily. Following the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052,** the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
