Report dated 22.04.2015 sent by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ropar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Randhir Singh, Davinder Singh son of Swaran Singh and Davinder Singh son of Darshan Singh as well as of complainant Sandeep Kaur it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the parties belong to the same very village and that the girl has since on the apologies of the accused given them up and that this compromise will go a long way to sort out the differences between the parties, FIR No.138 dated 19.06.2014 under Sections 354, 295-A and 34 IPC Police Station, Morinda District Ropar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
