Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 88, dated 21.05.2015, under Sections 452, 324, 323, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Ghall Khurd, District Ferozepur.

Perusal of the FIR shows that there are serious allegations levelled against the petitioners to the effect that petitioner no.1 was armed with dang and caused injury on the person of the complainant,

which hit on right side of his head. Although the injuries have been

declared as simple, but it is on the vital part of the body. Injuries have been caused by petitioner no.2 – Gurmej Singh with stick blow. Not only this, the petitioners along with others who were armed with deadly weapons have caused injuries by entering into the house of the victims. In this case, custodial interrogation is necessary for effecting the recovery of weapons.

In view of this, no ground for anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
