The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.210 dated 18.06.2015 registered under Sections 332/353/323/186/148/149/427 IPC at Police Station Sadar Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the accused Mahinder Singh was arrested on 19.06.2015 but his arrest was not shown. It was urged that Lucknow Police had come to arrest the accused but later the arrest of the accused was shown from Uttar Pradesh, on the next day and it was a false case. It was urged that the petitioners have already joined the investigation and no recovery is to be effected.

Learned State counsel submits that Mahinder Singh was wanted in case of theft in a train and the police from Lucknow had come to arrest him at his village and the family started pelting stones at the police party and they try to resist the arrest and seven police officials

were injured and the petitioners had obstructed in the official work. It was also urged that the police party could move out of the village only with the help of additional police force.

Learned State counsel had shown the copies of the MLRs.

Mahinder Singh had been arrested on 19.06.2015 at 10.30 AM as per Annexure P-2. The police party had gone to the village the previous day to arrest him. The allegations are that the petitioners attacked the police party and pelted stones and injured seven of them.

Considering the allegations, no case for anticipatory bail is made out. The petitioners had not only obstructed in the work but also took law in their hands. They are not entitled to the discretionary relief of anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed.
