MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in terms of Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR no. 228 dated 4.12.2014 registered under Sections 406, 420 IPC at Police Station Division no. 1, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

The petitioner is in custody since 26.1.2015 and trial is in progress. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that noticing the period of incarceration he deserves the concession of bail.

Having regard to the facts that trial is to be conducted by the Magistrate and the fact that the petitioner is in custody since January, 2015 and also considering the fact that the trial is likely to take some time, instant petition is accepted. It is directed that the petitioner be released on bail in terms of Section 439 Cr.P.C. Bail to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court.

Nothing said herein shall be construed to be an expression on the merits of the case.
