Petitioner seeks the concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Ram Mehar alleging that his son Jagbir had, on receipt of a telephone call from co-accused Sachin had gone to his plot where the complainant had seen Sachin and four others quarreling with deceased. Deceased was fired at by all.

So far as petitioner is concerned, he is not named in the FIR but has been implicated on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused

Sachin that petitioner had facilitated the crime by keeping a track of the deceased and that he had helped the accused to commit the crime.

Counsel for the State while opposing the petition states that petitioner alongwith Sunny and Sachin had tried to trace Jaggi deceased.

In view of no specific injury and attribution regarding any specific injury having been inflicted by the petitioner, it will be debatable if the petitioner, on the basis of the material available on the record, could be said to have conspired with co-accused. Petitioner can be granted the concession of bail being in custody w.e.f. February 16, 2014.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
