Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising out of FIR No. 92, dated 08.04.2013, registered at Police Station Julana, District Jind, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that charge has

been framed and three witnesses have also been examined. The petitioner has been behind bars since 24.09.2014. The learned counsel further contends that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that trial would not be concluded in near future, the petitioner can be granted concession of bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Jind.
