Petitioner, by way of instant petition, under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeks quashing of impugned order dated 15.05.2015 (Annexure P-5), passed by the learned trial Court whereby application of the petitioner for getting report from the Handwriting Experts regarding modification in the Cheque Ex.C-1 at point 'X' and 'Z' after taking photographs, was dismissed by the learned trial Court.

Notice of motion was issued and pursuant thereof, learned counsel for the respondent has put in appearance. He fairly states that he has got the clear instructions to say that the respondent has no objection in case the instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is permitted to get the report from the Handwriting Experts for modification in the Cheque Ex.C-1 at point 'X' and 'Z', after taking photographs thereon.

In view of the fair statement made by the learned counsel for the respondent, instant petition is allowed. Impugned order dated 15.05.2015, passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Pathankot, is hereby set aside. Application moved by the petitioner would stand allowed. Learned trial Court is directed to proceed further with the trial, in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the parties are also ad idem that let the learned trial Court be directed to expedite the trial.
