This order will dispose of two petitions titled “Hari Om and ors. vs. State of Punjab and ors.” and “Surinder Kumar and ors. vs. State of Punjab and ors.” for quashing of FIR No.68 dated 04.07.2013 under Sections 452/323/354/427/148/149 IPC, Police Station Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Ram Saroop and cross version case DDR No.38 (a) dated 04.07.2013 under Sections 452/324/323/148/149 IPC and Section 325 & 326 IPC added later on vide DDR No.28(A) dated 30.07.2013, recorded at the instance of Hari Om against Surinder Kumar and ors, on the allegation of assault on each other as members of unlawful assembly.

Both the parties were directed to appear before the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Hoshiarpur to get their statements recorded as the matter having been compromised. It has been reported by the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Garhshankar that the matter has been voluntarily compromised. Following the judgment of Full Bench of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh vs. State of Punjab and others 2007(3) RCR(CrL)1052** the above said FIR and DDR are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to the condition that both the parties will deposit a sum of Rs.10,000/- each with the Punjab Police Welfare Fund, Sector 9, Chandigarh within a period of one month.
