Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the lives and liberty of petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

Notice to respondents No.1 to 3, only at this stage.

On the asking of Court, Ms. Priyanka Sadar, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a representation dated July 20, 2015 (Annexure P-2) was made to Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar but till date no action has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case representation dated July 20, 2015 (Annexure P-2) is dealt with and dispose of within a stipulated period.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to look into the grievances unfolded by petitioners in their representation dated July 20, 2015 (Annexure P-2) and in case found some substance therein, take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of certified copy of this copy.

However, a direction is also issued to Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to provide adequate security to the petitioners in case there is an apprehension to their lives and liberty and their family members at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.
