Keeping in view that the parties belong to the same very village and have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and to bring about harmonious atmosphere and keeping in view that the complainant has since died and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052,**
