Report dated 26.3.2015 sent by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ferozepur has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Satpal Chaudhary as well as of complainant Rajesh Kumar Khullar it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that there is purely a quarrel between the parties and the same has now been settled by way of compromise and that the compromise will go a long way to sort out the differences between the parties and to bring about harmonious atmosphere, FIR No.210 dated 10.10.2010 under Sections 307,506,148,149 IPC read with Sections 25,54 and 59 of Arms Act, and Section 3,4 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984 Police

Station, City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.

Petition stands disposed off.
