The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 by the petitioners for giving direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to protect their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

As per the averments mentioned in the petition, the petitioners have solemnized their marriage on 26.07.2015 against the wishes of the private respondents. They are major and they apprehend the threat to their life and liberty at the hands of the private respondents.

Mr. A.S. Barnala, Advocate, learned counsel for respondents No.4 & 6 i.e. father and brother of petitioner No.2, has stated at bar that private respondents will not cause any harm to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

But learned counsel for the petitioners states that still the petitioners apprehend threat to their life and liberty and they have already moved the representation to this effect the the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga for providing them the protection to protect their life and liberty.

Thus, without going into the validity of the marriage between the petitioners, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga to consider the representation dated 27.07.2015 Annexure P-4 and after assessing the threat precession to the petitioners, to provide necessary protection to safeguard their life and liberty, so that no harm can be caused to them.
