The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 489 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.179 dated 29.03.2008, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 506, 467, 468 IPC at Police Station City Panipat, District Panipat.

The reasoning given by the petitioner is that he was in custody in another case and on that account he could not appear. However, during the course of arguments, it emerges that the petitioner was released on bail in another case on 21.02.2015 and thereafter, on 11.06.2015 he was declared proclaimed offender. The petitioner has not cared to appear for four months even after he was granted bail. Otherwise also, two other cases i.e. FIR No.216 dated 30.11.2005, registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Madhuban, District Karnal and FIR No.196 dated

24.10.2005, registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Madhuban, District Karnal, are pending against the petitioner.

So, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
