By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case, FIR No. 96 dated 19.07.2014, registered under Section 306 IPC, at Police Station Moonak, District Sangrur.

The learned counsel contends that the co-accused of the petitioner had already been enlarged on bail by this Court, vide order dated 16.10.2014 and 29.08.2014 (Annexure P-7 & P-8) respectively. In pursuance of the order dated 27.01.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that

in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 27.01.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
