REKHA MITTAL, J.

The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (in short "Cr.P.C.") primarily to express his grievance that his application for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 61 dated 3.6.2014 registered at Police Station, Division No. 6, Industrial Area Ludhiana for offence punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code (in short "IPC") is not being decided by the Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana as this Court in CRM M- 35211 of 2014 Jagjit Singh vs,. State of Punjab and others whereby the petitioner has prayed for transfer of investigation of the aforesaid FIR to some senior police officer, had stayed further proceedings in the FIR.

The petition stands disposed of with a direction to the Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana to dispose of the bail application on its merit as stay granted by this Court cannot be construed to stand in disposal of bail plea, in accordance with law.
