JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Petitioner is seeking a direction to the Police Authorities for protecting his life and liberty at the hands of his wife, son, daughter and in-laws.

It is submitted that the petitioner has come back from England after 10 years and it transpires that the immovable property has been transferred under the ownership of his *Bhabhi* whereas the petitioner alleges that she has purchased from him thus the dispute appears to have arisen between the family.

On previous dates this Court, at the willingness of the petitioner to pay for his security, had directed the State to work out the security charges payable per month to the police personnel to be deputed.

At the time of hearing learned State Counsel has filed an

affidavit dated 31.08.2015 of Sh. Jagdish Raj, Inspector, SHO Police Station Tanda wherein the tentative expenditure of Rs.3,12,575/- per moth has been detailed. The said proposal is not accepted by the counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid, this Court is of the opinion that the apprehension of the petitioner of threat at the hands of his family members is premature as nothing untoward till now is stated to have happened.

In view of the above, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is hereby dismissed.
