Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No. 318 dated 26.11.2012, under Sections 420, 406 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar (**Annexure P-2**) and also order dated 25.05.2013 (**Annexure P-3**) declaring the petitioner as proclaimed offender on the basis of compromise.

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The allegations against the petitioner are that he has received ₹42,50,000/- from the respondent No.2 for securing the admission of his son for MBBS course under NRI quota in the year 2012-13.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that there is no compromise between the parties, the partial amount sought to be refunded through cheques has also not materialized, since the cheque got dishonoured. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is playing hide & seek with the Court. He further submits that none is appearing on behalf of the petitioner since last two dates and same is the position today.

None is appearing since last two dates and the position is same today.

In view of above, the present petition stands dismissed for non-prosecution.
