Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuing appropriate directions to the respondents to arrest the accused or to direct them to join the investigation in order to recover the incriminating articles/materials from them.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that despite the dismissal of anticipatory bail, the police is not taking any action against the accused and in order to seek justice from the respondent police, the petitioner has submitted a representation (Annexure P-18) dated 26.6.2015 but no action has been taken on the said representation.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the

respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, is directed to look into the contents of the representation (Annexure P-18) and to take appropriate action as warranted by law expeditiously.
