Petitioner absented on September 9, 2014 in proceedings under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act claiming that he had gone to religious place.

Without entering into the controversy, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition in limine in order to save the further harassment to the complainant.

Petition is disposed of with a direction that petitioner will appear before the trial Court within a period of 15 days or on next date of hearing whichever is earlier alongwith a bank draft of Rs.10000/- in the

name of the complainant as cost for unnecessary harassment to the complainant. In case of petitioner's doing so, his bail bonds/ surety bonds will be accepted. Bank draft of Rs.10000/- will be handed over to the complainant as cost of adjournment. In case the complainant is not happy with this order, it will be open to him to approach this Court for review of the order.
