By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.54, dated 06.05.2014, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452, 506, 307, 364 and 216 IPC, at Police Station Raipur Rani, District Panchkula.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioners are not named in the FIR. The specific role of having given a sword blow on the person of injured Ashok Kumar is attributed to co-accused Sanju. The petitioners have been involved in the present case on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused

Malkeet and Harjinder Singh @ Makhan. In pursuance of the order dated 25.07.2014, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 25.07.2014, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
