The petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

The trial Court shall expedite the trial and conclude the same preferably within three months. In case, the trial is not concluded within the aforesaid period, the petitioner shall be at liberty to move an application before the trial Court for grant of bail. It is made clear that this time limit has been fixed with a presumption that the petitioner shall not prolong the trial.
