Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.56 dated 16.4.2015, under Sections 363, 366-A and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Adampur, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that apart from the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 16.4.2015, the parties have entered into a compromise dated 26.6.2015.

Mr. S.S. Virk, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2-complainant Seema, who had lodged the FIR, admits

the factum of compromise.

However, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harpreet Singh states that in the case in hand the challan has been presented but the charges have not been framed.

Considering the fact that the parties have entered into compromise, the petitioner is admitted on regular subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar.

The petition is disposed of.
