On the instructions from ASI Gurcharan Singh, it has been informed that the petitioner has joined investigation.

Application has been opposed on the ground that the petitioner had allegedly relations with the deceased for the last 10-15 years though she was married to Gulshan Makkar.

It appears that as per prosecution version there is a duel version regarding the reasons for deceased Milli Makkar having committed suicide.

Perusal of the allegations in the FIR indicate that complainant Veena Rani levelled allegations that her daughter had committed suicide as her husband had illicit relations with his sister-in-law Veena Makkar. The name of the petitioner was not mentioned in the FIR but has cropped up during course of the investigation. The petitioner has been involved in the case on the basis of call details.

It will certainly be a debatable issue during trial whether the role attributed to the petitioner, if any, would constitute abetment as per provisions of Section 107 IPC.

This petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of the petitioner, he will be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the condition that he will not tamper with the evidence or hamper investigation in any manner.
