This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure preferred by Ved Parkash Yadav seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members from the hands of respondents No.3 to 9.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 2 only, at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Ashima Mor, APP, UT, Chandigarh has accepted notice on behalf of the UT, Chandigarh. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel, during the course of the day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that though a complaint dated November 14, 2014 (Annexure P-1) was moved to respondent No.2-Deputy Inspector General of Police, Chandigarh Police, Chandigarh but till today no action has been taken.

Petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Deputy Inspector General of Police, Chandigarh Police, Chandigarh to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his complaint dated

November 14, 2014 (Annexure P-1) and in case, some substance is found, take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
