Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in a case arising from FIR No. 306, dated 26.04.2015, under Sections 323, 325, 341, 307, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Hansi, District Hissar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that no injury has been attributed to the petitioners. Even the name of the petitioners do not figure in the FIR. The petitioners have been arrayed as accused with the help of Sections 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code. Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that the petitioners have been behind bars since 13.05.2015 they are not required for custodial interrogation.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that trial would not be concluded in near future, the petitioners can be granted concession of bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioners are ordered to be released on bail, on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Hissar.
