Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.35 dated 18.6.2015, under Sections 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Ghanie Ke Bangar, District Gurdaspur.

This Court vide order dated 31.8.2015 has granted interim bail to the petitioner on the basis of order passed in Criminal Misc. No. M-24185 of 2015 titled 'Harjinder Singh vs. State of Punjab'.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, pursuant to the order dated 31.8.2015 has joined the

investigation.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Darshan Singh, has stated that petitioner Harjinder Singh was not attributed grievous injury, whereas, petitioner Jasbir Singh has been attributed the injury on the right leg and, therefore, is not entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and gone through the case file.

The injury attributed to the petitioner Jasbir Singh is not on the vital part of the body of complainant and co-accused Harjinder Singh has already been granted interim bail by this Court.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 31.8.2015 are made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
