Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.68 dated 4.6.2011 registered under Sections 420/511/465/468/471 IPC at Police Station Phase-I, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali.

Notice of the present petition was issued. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already disclosed the source of his certificates, which were allegedly found to be forged. He further submits that petitioner himself is a victim in the case. On disclosing the source of alleged forged certificates, a separate FIR has been registered against the persons running the said institute at Bathinda.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties at considerable length, present petition is allowed. In the event of his arrest, petitioner shall be released

on anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. However, the petitioner shall be joining the investigation as and when required. He shall also abide by the conditions under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.,

Disposed of, accordingly.
