This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 323, 324, 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station, Sekhwan, District, Gurdaspur vide F.I.R No. 31 dated 16.5.2015.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI-Sardul Singh, who is present in court, submits that pursuant to order dated 31.7.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated is hereby made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
