Petitioner along with his co-accused had allegedly committed irregularities in the development works under the Municipal Council Sirsa.

Co-accused of the petitioner has been granted the concession of pre-arrest bail. Pursuant to the interim order passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined investigation.

It is an admitted fact that on the basis of irregularities alleged, no amount has been released to the concerned contractor.

Without prejudice to the civil rights of the parties, this petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioner, he will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the conditions that he will not tamper with the evidence or hamper the investigation in any manner.
