Petitioner is a proclaimed offender. On account of his status as proclaimed offender, he was not able to seek benefit of the acquittal order which has been passed qua the co-accused of the petitioner.

No indulgence can be shown to a person who is a proclaimed offender in the above said circumstances.

This petition is disposed of as not maintainable with liberty to the petitioner to seek his release on bail in accordance with law on the basis of the acquittal of his co-accused and to seek quashing on the basis of

compromise, if any. Petitioner will be at liberty to approach this Court again in case the matter is compromised.
