Notice of motion.

State counsel, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

It is submitted by counsel for the petitioner that representation (Annexure P3) was made before the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Ferozepur Range, Ferozepur, who marked it to respondent No. 5 with a stipulation that report would be submitted to the officer concerned within fifteen days, but till now nothing has been done by respondent No. 5.

Respondent No. 5, i.e. Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jalalabad, District Ferozepur, is directed to decide the representation of the petitioner (Annexure P3) within thirty days from the date of receipt of copy of the order and submit the report before the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Ferozepur Range, Ferozepur, immediately thereafter.

The Deputy Inspector General of Police, Ferozepur Range,

Ferozepur, had written a letter (Annexure P4) to Superintendent of Police, Fazilka, for getting the matter inquired from Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jalalabad, and to get a report filed within fifteen days and in the same letter an endorsement was made that further proceedings in the above said case be stopped and direction be given to the Station House Officer of Police Station Gurhar Sahai to forward the case file to Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jalalabad.

It is contended that despite that order passed by the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Ferozepur Range, Ferozepur, an application was moved before the Court by the Station House Officer of Police Station Gurhar Sahai to issue arrest warrant against the petitioner.

It is, therefore, directed that till the report is submitted by respondent No. 5 to the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Ferozepur Range, Ferozepur, no further proceedings relating to the FIR in question shall be taken.

The petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
