Prayer is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.PC to the petitioner Surjeet in case FIR No.1201 dated 07.10.2011 for offences punishable under Sections 302, 34, 120-B, 216 and 365 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act registered with Police Station City, Panipat.

As per the allegations, the Petitioner had taken the deceased from the house in his car and subsequently dead body of Pardeep was found. The Petitioner during investigation has also got recovered the weapon of offence and also got the demarcation of the area from where the dead body and the abandoned car was recovered.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Naresh Kumar states that the petitioner was also involved in another dacoity case.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner states that in the said other case, the petitioner was acquitted, however, concedes that the acquittal was based on witnesses having turned hostile.

Be that as it may, keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offences, no case for grant of regular bail to the Petitioner-Surjeet is made out.

Dismissed.
